## You will need:



Silky Beads (A) 63 pieces
O-Beads (B) 7,5 grams

Super Duo beads/ Super Uno Beads (C). 10 grams SD (or 5 grams SD and 5 grams SU)
KO thread in the right color

## Attention:

You can use only Super Duo beads, or you can choose to use Super Uno beads in step 1 and 7 instead of Super Duos

In the drawings you see less beads than you have to use for a full bracelet.


Pick up $A, B, C, B$ and repeat this $20 x$ for a bracelet of 18 cm without the clasp (a total of 21 A beads). End this row with an $A$ bead and pass back through the second hole of that A bead (In this step you can use Super Uno beads instead of Super Duo beads)


Pick up $B, C, B$ and pass through the second hole of the next $A$ of the previous row. Repeat until the end.

Pick up $1 \times B$ and $1 \times C$ and pass back through the second hole of the $C$ bead

Pick up $B, A, B$ and pass through the second hole of the next $C$ bead of the previous row. Repeat this until you passed through the last $C$ bead. Pass back through the second hole of that $C$ bead.


Pass through the $B, A, B, C$ (you added in previous steps). Pass back through the second hole of the $C$ bead. Pass through the $B$ and $A$ bead (you added in the previous step) and pass back through the second hole of the A bead (see thread path in picture 4).


Repeat step 2.


Repeat step 3 and 4.


Repeat step 2, but end your row after the last A bead (you can use Super Uno beads instead of Super Duo beads).

Finally add your clasp.
